### Waypoints

---

#### 1 Blaen y Glyn car park

(51.84398; -3.36134)

Leave the car park and turn left over the bridge and then left following the path keeping the river to your left.

#### 2 Wooden bridge

(51.84720; -3.36499)

Wooden bridge facing the highest waterfall. Do not cross this (it takes you back to the car park) but follow the path to the right of the river.

#### 3 Stile

(51.85412; -3.36423)

Keep to the right of the river. The path follows the river uphill at a fairly even gradient. The path is narrow and rocky, low tree branches and can get extremely wet and boggy in places.



## 4 Blaen Caerfanell

(51.85780; -3.36632)

Leave the forest and follow the path in open country by the stream. From you will see the stream fall off the ridge above down into the valley. There is an option to continue following the path by the stream further up the valley. Otherwise turn left and follow the path back across the open country towards and into the forest.

## 5 Forestry path

(51.85075; -3.36891)

Turn right onto the path and follow it back towards the upper Blaen y Glyn car park.

## 6 Car park access road

(51.84889; -3.37187)



Cross the cattle grid and turn immediately right up a series of stone steps with the stream to your left. This path is steep and can be very wet and boggy in places. When the path reaches the end of the forest on your right return carefully back down the the cattle grid. If you don't want to ascend this path, recross the cattle grid and turn right down a path down through the woodland behind the picnic bench on the right hand side of the car park.

## 7 Blaen y Glyn forest

(51.84871; -3.37134)

This path takes you back through woodland to the lower Blaen y Glyn car park.
